- b. The entire committee including Roger Wilkerson will discuss the nine artist's bio and work samples and make the final selection of six LXS artists based following the criteria:
 - 1. Artistic excellence
 - 2. Variety of men and women artists
 - 3. An assortment of emerging and established artists, but must be practicing professional artists
 - 4. Artists who work in different media and styles
 - 5. Artists who have not previously exhibited their artwork in a LXS show
 - 6. Artists whose work is suitable for public spaces.
 - 7. Artists from across the state (rural/Las Vegas/Reno)
