PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

Notice of Hearing for the Amendment and Adoption of Regulations of the Nevada Arts Council Board, as proposed in LCB File No. R099-18

The Nevada Arts Council Board will hold a public hearing at 1:30 p.m., on the 13th day of December 2019, at 716 North Carson Street, Suite A, Carson City, Nevada 89701 in the Conference Room and via video-conferencing to Nevada Arts Council's Southern Office, 4000 S. Eastern Avenue, Ste 240, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment and adoption of regulations that pertain to Chapter 233C of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

This regulation is needed to update NAC Chapter 233C generally and to comply with 233B.100. Prior to the current amendment, NAC Chapter 233C has not been amended since 2004.

2. For a temporary regulation, the terms or the substance of the proposed regulation to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved.

This is a permanent regulation.

3. For a proposed regulation, a statement explaining how to obtain the approved or revised text of the proposed regulation.

4. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately and, in each case, must include:

This regulation will involve no economic effect on businesses or the public. This regulation will involve no adverse or beneficial effects on businesses or the public. This regulation will also involve no immediate or long-term effects on businesses or the public.

5. The methods used by the agency in determining the impact on a small business.

The Nevada Arts Council has reviewed the text of the regulation. Because the regulation creates a process for interested persons to petition the Nevada Arts Council Board for the adoption, filing, amendment or

repeal of any regulation and provides some updates to the Nevada Arts Council grant regulations, this regulation will have no impact on small businesses.

6. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.

The Nevada Arts Council Board does not anticipate a cost for the enforcement of the propose regulation. This proposed regulation creates a process for interested persons to petition the Nevada Arts Council Board for the adoption, filing, amendment or repeal of any regulation. The Nevada Arts Council Board does not anticipate that many petitions will be filed pursuant to the proposed regulation and anticipates deciding any petitions that are filed at regularly scheduled meetings whenever possible and utilizing technology to schedule a meeting by videoconference or teleconference if a special meeting is necessary to decide a petition within the required time frame. The Nevada Arts Council Board already has a grants process and the changes to NAC 233C regarding the grants process will not have a cost to the Nevada Arts Council Board.

7. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.

This regulation does not overlap or duplicate any regulations of other state or local government agencies. This regulation does not overlap or duplicate any federal regulations.

8. If the regulation is required pursuant to federal law, a citation and description of the federal law.

This regulation is not required pursuant to federal law.

9. If the regulation includes provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.

This regulation does not include provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity. This regulation deals only with the process for interested persons to petition the Nevada Arts Council Board for the adoption, filing, amendment or repeal of any regulation as required by NRS Chapter 233B.100 and makes minor changes to the Nevada Arts Council's grants process. This regulation does not regulate any activity that is governed by a federal regulation.

10. Whether the proposed regulation establishes a new fee or increases an existing fee.

This regulation does not establish a new fee or increase an existing fee. This regulation deals only with the process for interested persons to petition the Nevada Arts Council Board for the adoption, filing, amendment or repeal of any regulation as required by NRS Chapter 233B.100 and makes minor changes to the Nevada Arts Council's grants process.

11. For a temporary regulation, each address at which the text of the regulation may be inspected and copied.

This regulation is not a temporary regulation; it is a permanent regulation.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada Arts Council may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Nevada Arts Council, Attn: Executive Director Tony Manfredi, 716 North Carson Street, Suite A, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Written submissions must be received by the Nevada Arts Council on or

before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 5, 2019. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the **Nevada Arts Council Board** may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.
